The concrete task is to formulate, as very short statements, an issue, case, or example of something that is controversial in society.  A few of the statements will be used as a basis for Hot & Cold (next exercise).	Each student writes down 1-2 issues or names them for the lecturer to write down.	1
Preparatory tasks for Students (if they needed):	When working with controversial issues, it is important that the students know each other. If the students are not acquainted, it is necessary that the lecturer allocates time for "ice breakers" and gives students an opportunity to get to know each other.			
Teacher's preparatory actions:	Sticky notes, white board (face-to-face session) or a board at an online platform (online session)			
Notes:	If the session is conducted online such online platforms as Padlet ( <a href="https://padlet.com/">https://padlet.com/</a> ), Menti ( <a href="https://www.menti.com/">https://miro.com</a> ) or Miro ( <a href="https://miro.com">https://miro.com</a> ) can be used.
